## **METHODS OF REMOTE TEACHING FOREIGN LANGUAGE**

In the modern world, at the time of constant political, economic, technical, cultural and educational development and progress, views on the teaching of disciplines with the use of a foreign language are changing. To begin with, the ways of internationalization are now being successfully introduced within the frames of international activities performed by modern higher education institutions. It can be scientific literature (theses, articles, monographs), educational and methodical literature (manuals, reference books, schemes), Internet resources. It is this material that substantiates the lexical and grammatical selection.

- the use of information creatively.

Creativeness and dynamics are an integral part of successful lesson while teaching foreign language. As the student should be involved and deepened into the discipline fully with total interest and desire. Willingness to study the subject due to the interest helps students to understand the subject better.

- the formation of graphic organizers.

A graphic organizer is a tool for written communication that uses graphic notation to represent knowledge, concepts, ideas, and the relationships and relationships between them.

- the use of interactive methods for remote studying foreign language.

Applying interactive resources for teaching such wonderful discipline as foreign language gives the opportunity to brighten the lesson for an academic staff member. There are various resources that are used by modern academic staff members to give the studied material in the interactive and interesting way. These tasks allow to revise the learned topic, to memorize the vocabulary, collocations, grammatical and lexical structures. Such tasks can be performed by academic staff members in hand on the online resource and all staff members can also share these tasks among one another.
