A law enforcement officer shall have, along with a certain set of highly professional competencies, the ability to communicate in native and foreign languages to solve professional tasks. Communication skills are necessary for a law enforcement officer to communicate with different categories of citizens. Foreign language competence contributes to establishing communicative interaction in solving international service issues, in significant situations of international professional communication. The success of a police officer's official activity often depends on his/her communication skills, as well as the ability to communicate

interaction with others.

In the course of their official activities, police officers constantly have tasks that need to be solved immediately and in a short time to recognize the nature of the event, assess it and make and make a decision. The solution to this problem depends largely on the readiness of police officers for professional communication.

The professional and communication culture of a police officer is a culture of human relations based on communication skills and the ability to organize the communication process.

Communication skills in the professional activity of a police officer involve the ability to listen, express oneself, maintain a conversation and change the subject, and find the right form of behaviour with citizens, and colleagues. It promotes contact, i.e. the ability to enter into psychological contact and form trusting relationships in the area of interaction. Given the presence of such professional qualities as sociability and contactability, we can talk about sociability as a personality quality of a police officer. Sociability is defined as the ability to group activities, mutual understanding, interpersonal and intercultural and intercultural interaction. The success of such activities is largely determined by the ability to competently and professionally build your communication.

Research shows that the development of communication skills in future law enforcement officers can be achieved by teaching not only special disciplines but also disciplines that form communication skills and communication culture skills. A leading role in this is undoubtedly played by a foreign language.

The foreign language course in higher education institutions of the Ministry of Internal Affairs is of the following types communicative, pragmatic and professionally oriented and is aimed not only at mastering communication skills in a foreign language by future law enforcement officers communication skills in a foreign language, but also at improving their professional competence.
